**A Resolution of the Scientific and Cultural Facilities District
Remembering Paul "P.K." Worley**

WHEREAS, today we honor the service, spirit and leadership of the late P.K. Worley to Denver Metro's cultural community; and

WHEREAS, P.K. devoted his life to the performing arts, serving in a variety of roles such as director, producer, performer, sound and music designer, musician, board member, and mentor; and

WHEREAS, P.K. was a native of Kansas and a 33-year resident of Evergreen, CO; and

WHEREAS, he was very involved in the performing arts community in Topeka, Kansas, helped start the Topeka Civic Theatre (TCT) in 1961, and was inducted into the TCT Hall of Fame in 1986; and

WHEREAS, P.K. was a vital member of the Evergreen Players for over 27 years, serving as director, producer, actor, and for over twenty years served as a board member, including as president; and

WHEREAS, he served 6 years as a board member of the Evergreen Arts Council, 3 years as its president, where he provided leadership during the organization's transition to the Center for the Arts Evergreen. In 2005, the organization awarded P.K. "Arts Person of the Year"; and


WHEREAS, P.K. directed for other organizations including, The Evergreen Chorale, Littleton Town Hall and Denver Civic Theater, and was a member of the Colorado Community Theatre Coalition board of directors; and

WHEREAS, from 2006 through 2011, P.K. was appointed by the Jefferson County Commissioners to serve his community as a member of Jefferson County Cultural Council, the body that allocates Jefferson County SCFD Tier III funds. In this capacity he distinguished himself serving in leadership roles as both chair and vice chair, as well as mentor, friend, and cultural advocate; and


