

RESOLUTION NO. 15-23

**A Resolution of the Scientific and Cultural Facilities District  
Pertaining to Organizations Qualifying for 2015 Tier II Formula and Discretionary Funds**

WHEREAS, 28 organizations submitted qualification applications by the May 29, 2015 deadline to the Scientific and Cultural Facilities District for 2015 funding as specified under CRS §32-13-107(3)(b); and

WHEREAS, each organization submitted by the July 8, 2015 deadline the required certification report for 2014 covering the previous year's distributions as required by the District; and

WHEREAS, each organization below has met statutory criteria for SCFD eligibility to receive the 95% formula funds as described in CRS §32-13-107(3)(b)(I) and has submitted a request for the 5% discretionary funds as described in CRS §32-13-107(3)(b)(III).

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE SCIENTIFIC AND CULTURAL FACILITIES DISTRICT AS FOLLOWS:
