


# Diversity, Equity & Inclusion

## Education

Our education does not stop when we leave school. The organizations of our region expand our minds and foster lifelong learning with informative programming for students of all ages.

#### Inaugural Engage-Empower-Connect Summit

SCFD and the Denver Botanic Gardens came together to offer organizations the opportunity to learn, network, and build their capacity through the Engage-Empower-Connect Summit. This day-long event was attended by nearly 150 participants and engaged organizations of all sizes and from across the metropolitan area.

## Genesis of a New Funding Opportunity

In 2017, SCFD began the process to create the Inclusivity Fund, a new grant focused on building capacity of smaller arts, culture, and science organizations and to support programming for underresourced communities. An advisory committee was formed with members of the community to lead this process and create a fund that promotes diversity, equity, and inclusion.

#### **SCFD Staff Grows**

The SCFD family grew in 2017 with the hiring of two Program Managers, Dana Manyothane and Marcus Turner. With a fully-staffed office, the SCFD staff was able to increase efficiency, support and communicate effectively with organizations, and produce networking and learning opportunities to better serve our community and region.
