FREE AND LOW COST OPPORTUNITIES

Many of SCFD's funded organizations provide other low cost ways to enjoy the arts, culture and science experiences available across the metro area. Here's just one:

SNAP: If you are enrolled in SNAP, a food assistance program commonly called food stamps, many SCFD partners have a deal for you. Just show your SNAP card and receive \$1 admission. Check the website of the organization you want to visit first to see if they offer this benefit.

Want to help chart your county's cultural future?

SCFD funding is distributed, in part, by each of the individual counties in the seven county metro area. These counties include Adams, Arapahoe, Boulder, Broomfield, Denver, Douglas and Jefferson counties. Funding from each of these counties is recommended by a volunteer resident's board -- called the County Cultural Council -- that reviews applications, holds interviews and determines county funding priorities. You must live in the county to serve on that county's council. Currently, two counties have openings on their councils. Learn more.
