Want to help chart your county's cultural future?

SCFD funding is distributed, in part, by each of the individual counties in the seven county metro area. These counties include Adams, Arapahoe, Boulder, Broomfield, Denver, Douglas and Jefferson counties. Funding from each of these counties is recommended by a volunteer resident's board -- called the County Cultural Council -- that reviews applications, holds interviews and determines county funding priorities. You must live in the county to serve on that county's council. Currently, four counties have openings on their councils. Learn more.

Arapahoe County

The Arapahoe Cultural Council solicits and screens applications from eligible non-profit and/or governmental entities for Arapahoe County's portion of the Scientific & Cultural Facilities District (SCFD) sales tax. For more information and to apply, please click here:

Boulder County

The successful applicant must be available to meet on the second Tuesday evening of each month and be willing to commit to a three-year term.
