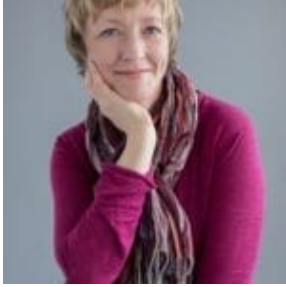
SCFD Board of Directors news
