0:28: A room full of people dance in unison.

0:30: A performer in a striped shirt reads a spoken word poem.

0:32: The Boulder Children's Chorale sings in front of a green background on stage as their director conducts them animatedly.

0:34: A group of performers in green and brown outfits rush across the stage in front of a man in a brown suit standing in front of a tall white building. The background of the stage is extremely colorful.
